1. Points will be awarded to the driver NOT the car or car owner.
2. You must start the feature race to receive points.
3. If you are unable to start the feature race, you will receive 10 points if you start the heat race. (Time Trials will qualify as a heat race.)
4. If a car is found to be illegal or disqualified for any reason, the driver will not receive any points for that night.
5. If a driver is disqualified there will be no points awarded for that night.
6. If the driver refuses to tear down after being protested, he is considered to be illegal and loses all points accumulated for that night.
7. Points cannot be transferred from one class to another.
8. No points will be dropped.
9. Maximum care field is 24 cars for the feature race.
10. If a driver is running for points and has car trouble during a race night, he will be able to drive another car from the same class and receive points; because the points go to the driver, not the car. In the event a driver does change cars, he must start in the rear of the feature.
11. In the event of a tie at the end of the points season, 1 point will be awarded to the driver with the most feature wins during the season to break the tie. In the event that both drivers have won the same number of features it will then be determined by the driver with the most 2nd place finishes.
